Would you like to learn the 2000 year old skill of preserving and maintaining hedgerows for wildlife, prevention of soil erosion, water run off and snow drifts as well as carbon sequestration?

This day long subsidised course is for villagers who would like to join our annual winter hedge restoration project. The cost is £10 thanks to a generous grant from East Suffolk's Nature First grant scheme. I'm ideally seeking participants who wish to commit to at least 1 day of volunteer hedge laying per year, once trained.
